

Graduation Requirements and Endorsement Information for Freshmen and Sophomores in 2015-2016

In order to graduate, students will need to complete 26 credits (see below for specific credits).

Students are only required to complete the requirements for one endorsement; however, many students will complete more than one endorsement.

Courses taken toward an endorsement can count as both the requirement for the endorsement and a core or elective requirement.

Courses taken beyond what is required for graduation are considered electives. Most students will graduate with more than 26 credits.

Students can take courses from any endorsement area even if they are not pursuing that endorsement (as long as they have the prerequisites required for the course).

Courses offered each year are dependent on enrollment.

Although students can change their selected endorsement and their four year plan at any time during the school year, all course change requests are due by August 1st, 2015. After Aug 1st, the student will be required to stay in the selected courses for the entire school year - even if the student has changed his/her endorsement or four year plan.

Students are also required to pass the End of Course (EOC) exams for English I, English II, Algebra I, US History, and Biology in order to graduate.
